### **Marin Ballet School-year 2010-2011 Registration & Tuition Payment Policies**

- ◆**Registration:** Enrollment in classes is on a first come first served basis. Receipt of a completed registration packet (including registration form, medical release, tuition payment, as well as registration and performance fees) is required to enroll in classes. Many of our classes reach their limit quickly. You will be notified by phone if your class choice is unavailable.
- ◆**Registration and Performance Fees:** A non-refundable Annual Registration Fee of \$75.00, applicable to all students, and a Performance Fee of \$60.00 (Levels 2-4) or \$75.00 (Levels 5-9) must accompany the first tuition payment.
- ◆**Tuition Due Dates:** Tuition payment is due in full according to the schedule below. Late payments are subject to a late fee of \$25.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Tuition Due: July 30, 2010
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Tuition Due: October 15, 2010
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Tuition Due: January 15, 2011
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Tuition Due: March 15, 2011
- ◆**Refunds:** Tuition is non-refundable once classes have begun. If you withdraw before the first class, you can receive a full refund of tuition. Exceptions due to special circumstances may be considered. The registration fee is non-refundable.
- ◆**Sibling Discount:** Families with more than one child enrolled pay full tuition for the child at the higher tuition and 90% of tuition for siblings at lesser tuitions.
- ◆**Withdrawals:** Enrollment in all Marin Ballet classes is for a school-year program (Sept.-June), which consists of four quarters. Marin Ballet automatically bills families for each quarter unless a family notifies us of withdrawal in writing. Marin Ballet maintains a waiting list for many classes. If we are not notified of your child's withdrawal, you will be responsible for tuition payment whether your child attended classes or not.
- ◆**Scholarships:** A limited number of scholarships are available based on financial need and are awarded on a first come first served basis to those who qualify. Applicants must be residents of Bay Area communities and must reapply each school year. Registration deadlines and class size limits apply to all applicants. Scholarship awards are for tuition only and do not apply to the registration and performance fees. Please submit your applications as far in advance of the start of classes as possible with a final deadline of July 30, 2010 for the 2010-2011 school-year. Applications may be obtained from the front office. Scholarships are awarded for the full school year. Please note that if you miss the application deadline, there may not be additional funds available.
